The Directors of DMTC Limited recognise the Uluru Statement from the Heart as a formative document in Australia's history, and as an invitation from First Nations Peoples for us to walk the reconciliation journey with them. This is in line with DMTC's Reconciliation Action Plan that affirms the Company's commitment to greater understanding and respect in relationships between Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples and other Australians.

We offer our support for Constitutional change to recognise Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders as the First Peoples of Australia.

We also acknowledge and support the call for a First Nations Voice to the Australian Parliament on matters affecting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples and communities.

We hear and accept the generous invitation that the Uluru Statement represents to walk side by side and contribute to a better future for all Australians.
